10. Level Director - Stephanie Worrell

a) \$100 increase for all levels, we will touch base back with Stephanie to check other associations tournament fees to see if we are in line.

11. Fundraising Director - Peggie Melnychuk

- a) How many fundraisers do we want to do, last year we did Cocobrooks and VIP meats. A Lot of fundraisers you need to pick up so the best ones are where they deliver. Swigs pretzels are an option as well. Depending on fees we can look into a raffle box, where you can pick the person who you support, so it goes directly to the hockey players fundraising fee.
- b) We can also look into getting onto the list for a casino rotation
- c) Mikaul Maygard made a Motion to vote on 1, or 2 personal fundraisers. Peggy Seconded the motion. By reason of vote, 2 personal fundraisers have been approved.

11. PR Director - Mike Lazenby -

a) Going and getting sponsorship for jerseys, mike will be connecting with executive members to help streamline for approaching business in town. We will also be getting new rink boards for U9, half ice boards and we can advertise business on these as well. Also we can look at getting a sign for the arena that says home of the devon drillers.

12. Ice Coordinator - Tina Pollock

- a) Tournaments schedule. U7- We were going to try and move it to the second week of Edmonton minor hockey week. However that will not work as Beaumont has theirs that week. We will keep U-7's that first week of February. U-11 November 10-12. U-15 November 17-19. Tina will have the draft schedule in the next week and she can make sure these fall into the natural breaks. U18 Dec 15-17. U-13 Jan 5-7
- b) Edmonton minor hockey week Jan 12-21st. Stephanie did suggest moving the U9 tournament to the second weekend. Tina has a call to EFHI and the coordinator for EMHW to see if the schedule will run similar to last year, ice was not used well.



- c) HSL rink being opened in nlsku, this may allow opening for ice in Calmar, we can look at ice if we need it.
- d) Nax has asked for ice in Oct, the 7-9 for their showcase event, which is typically when we run evaluations for U18, and the weekend the reff clinic will run.
- 13. Equipment Manager Kim Simon
 - a) Kim has put her name forward as equipment Manager, all in Favor.
 - b) Rainie will get Brittany a list of jerseys given to graduating players to see if we need to order more.
 - c) When we order, we need to look at the A,C,D as they look the same. We can also look at socks that more closely match, to make ordering from other places.
