Coordinator

- Carrie has reached out to all Level Coordinators to get them to complete the Member Information form needed to open the accounts with Servus. (14 Sept 2023).
- Each of these new accounts will require online access, the Treasurer (Carrie Chang) will be the administrator with full access for all of these accounts and will obtain written approval (email from DMHA emails is sufficient) from the second signor prior to any electronic transfers being conducted out of the account
- DMHA Credit Card- Carrie has discussed with Servus and we are able to set up a DMHA Credit Card that can be used for subscriptions (i.e. GoDaddy, Quickbooks, etc.), orders where credit card is only accepted method (i.e. Vistaprint, online purchases), or any other needs.
- Would like to propose that we go ahead and obtain the business Mastercard with Servus, with the Corporate Administrator, authorized user and cardholder as the Treasurer (this can be changed in the future should the Executives wish to do so). The name on the card should be Devon Minor Hockey Association.
- Discussion regarding requested limit for the credit card, motion made by Mikaul for \$6000 limit, seconded by Nicole. Since we will be able to pay immediately onto the card if we have to make multiple purchases, provided each purchase is less than the limit the Treasurer would be able to pay it off in between. Mikaul Mayguard made a motion to obtain the card. Nicole Howatt seconded.
- Alex Gomez made a motion to purchase a new laptop for the referee assignor position, Stephanie Worell seconded. (\$1000 limit)
- Restricted Accounts outline- Carrie created an outline for our internally restricted
 accounts that details what we are approved to utilize the funds for (rather than
 the general statement "equipment"). Received some feedback and asked that if
 you haven't reviewed it, please do so. Carrie will advise the Executive for a last
 review and have the voting members approve the finalized guidance document.
